

QUESTION: Is baghouse dust (from an incinerator that burns a non-fossil fuel) that is EP toxic for heavy metals, a sludge for the purposes of recycling according to 261.6?

ANSWER: Baghouse dust that is not excluded under 261.4 (b) (4) is considered a sludge according to the definition in 260.10. Therefore, if hazardous by the characteristic, the baghouse dust is subject to regulation under 261.6 (b) with respect to transportation and storage.

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
